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TREASURER'S REPORT

NORTHWEST OHIO ASSOCIATION

Blessings to all from the Northwest Ohio Association of the United Church of Christ. As we come together for the Annual Meeting this year, we are reminded that "seeing is believing" especially if you are a doubting Thomas. It's great to be together. The year 2022 has seen challenges both positive and negative. Let me begin by addressing some of the negatives.

- A review of the December, 2022 NWOA Balance Sheet enclosed at the end of the pink section of your annual report, shows Assets and Liabilities in balance for year end.
- Certificates of Deposit both matured prior to year-end, with the following changes. The amount of \$25,000 from the Cornerstone Certificate was reinvested in the United Church Funds. This was done to achieve a better position in our gains/losses in recovering interest rates. The balance in the Cornerstone certificate balance is now \$10,442.25. This will increase the United Church Funds balance of \$221,847.62 by \$25,000 in 2023.
- The United Church Fund and the Cornerstone CD Interest total income earned in 2022 was \$1,387. The retained earnings in interest for 2022 was (\$990) less than in 2021. We look for this to recover when investment funds stabilize in 2023.
- The UCF interest income portion of \$1,006.77 was appropriated to the NWOA Permanent Restricted Scholarships. However, we also suffered a loss of (\$14,335) in UCF Interest/Dividends under NWOA Unrealized (LOSS) under expenses. This will impact and reduce balances in Permanent Restricted Scholarships as seen on NWOA Funds Report.
- The 2022 ending checking account Balance was \$65,487.91.

The NWOA Budget Worksheet and Proposal is also enclosed at the end of the pink section of your annual report. It has been challenging to project Fed interest rates increasing at a rate impossible to comprehend and to follow consumer spending prices and inflation. The first and second column of the NWOA Budget Worksheet demonstrate just how close we were able to project the 2022 year end. However, the anticipated projections in the last two columns (thru 2023 and for 2024) is the real challenge.

It's not all bad news. The Budget Worksheet (in the pink section) allowed for \$104,077 to be sent to Heartland Conference for 2022. This was prayerfully received through the continued support of our UCC Churches having donated funds to the NWOA. This amount is roughly \$1,100 more than was gifted in 2021.

As members of our congregations are returning to church in body, we see in-person conference meetings reconvening and a need to modify office expenses. We also anticipate upcharges in utility costs and budgeting for more in travel expenses. With diligent decision-making and watchful administration of income/expenses from our dedicated NWOA Office Staff we finished the year with gratitude. Therefore, we want to compensate NWOA Office Staff with incentives and salary increases within inflationary measures. We will no doubt continue to be influenced by inflation, the cost-of-living index and by the force expenses will impact proposed budgets on a continuing basis. Overall, we are pleased to address this annual meeting with a positive influence supported monetarily by our affiliated UCC churches which provide the opportunity to support OCWM and our Heartland Conference.

Our Church's Wider Mission... In The Northwest Ohio Association

The Northwest Ohio Association is a community of local churches and pastors working together and supporting one another to strengthen the ministry and mission of Jesus Christ. Our strength is in our connections. Below are some examples of how our churches are impacted by our connections as an Association.

1. What are some ways we support local churches?

- Provide individuals available to assist churches in areas such as stewardship, conflict, Christian education, youth ministry, pastoral misconduct, church revitalization
- Resource and support search processes for new local church pastoral leadership
- > Make grants for revitalization through the Covenant Fund
- Refer those interested in resources to the National Church Resource Center online store
- Process and direct financial gifts to local and global missions

We also support leadership development through the NWOA Lay School of Religion (a five-year program of classes) and various workshops and information for lay leaders.

2. In what ways do we support pastors and authorized ministers?

- Provide Special Events such as Church Professional Retreat, Retired Ministers' Luncheon, Periodic Support Consultations, Boundary Training
- Encourage networking within Regions
- Provide assistance in seeking new settings for ministry
- > Offer pastoral care
- Encourage "Situational Support Consultations" to address difficulties
- Provide emergency financial assistance

We also encourage individuals who are seeking a call to ordained ministry through guidance in the Discernment Process, making scholarship grants, and supporting our seminaries through CUE.

3. We also celebrate and strengthen our ministry together through the following ways:

youth events; leadership for confirmation and other summer camps; joint mission projects, Association meetings, installations, connections to the mission and ministries of the Heartland Conference, UCC Covenanted Ministries, and ecumenical settings.

4. How do churches and individuals know about these ministries and missions?

The Association has E-News "*The Vine*" which is a group email to all NWOA churches, to all authorized ministers and all volunteers on NWOA teams and committees along with those interested in the Association news. The Association website <u>www.nwoa.org</u> has resources and events of the Association. The Heartland Conference has E-News "The *Connections*" which is available at <u>https://heartlanducc.org</u>.

The work of the Northwest Ohio Association is funded by giving to Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) and directed gifts to the Association. 62% of OCWM Basic Support remains within the Association to support our work.

Frequently Asked Questions About Our Church's Wider Mission and CUE

Q. How are Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) funds used?

Our goal is faithful service to Jesus Christ through the use of our resources.

In 2023, the OCWM financial goal is \$285,000. With income from other sources (directed giving, interest, etc) it is anticipated that the income will be \$354,425. Of the OCWM financial goal, \$176,700 is budgeted to remain in the Association where it will be used to help churches find pastors, provide education/resources for laity and clergy, support churches seeking to be involved in church revitalization, connect churches with one another and the wider church. \$108,300 is budgeted to be sent to the Heartland Conference. The Conference will retain 65% of this to support summer camps and retreat opportunities; youth, education, and spirituality resources; our connections with ecumenical partners and the wider ministries of the UCC. The other 35% is sent to the national ministries of the UCC which provide local and overseas mission work, written and video resources in all areas of local church life, the pension program, health and property insurance, programs in justice and witness, programs for youth, women and men's groups.

Q. Who makes the decision about allocation of OCWM funds?

Lay and clergy delegates who attend the Annual Meetings of the Northwest Ohio Association, the Heartland Conference and the General Synod of the United Church of Christ make decisions about the allocations of their respective funds.

Q. Can we designate our OCWM funding?

The Association encourages its churches to support unified OCWM funding with support being distributed to the Association, Conference and National Ministries of the United Church of Christ. However, a congregation does have the right to designate its OCWM support to the Association, Conference or certain ministries of the National UCC.

Q. How do we communicate our OCWM goal to the Association?

Please indicate your goal on the Goal Sheet and forward it to the Association Office.

Q. Are we obligated to meet the OCWM goal we adopt?

Congregations are asked to do their best to meet or exceed their goal. Churches that anticipate a significant shortfall are asked to communicate that information to the Association.

Q. What is CUE?

CUE is the way in which we help to fund the three UCC seminaries in our region: Eden Theological Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri; Chicago Theological Seminary in Chicago, Illinois; and United Theological Seminary in New Brighton, Minnesota.

Q. How is our congregation's goal for CUE calculated?

The recommendation is that each church give the equivalent of 2% of their local operating expenses reported for the previous year.

Q. How much of OCWM that stays in the Association is used for administration?

Of every dollar, 87 cents is used to support our work with churches seeking pastors, churches having difficulties, church revitalization, celebrations, pastoral care and support, communications with churches, pastors, Heartland Conference, national ministries and ecumenical ministries. It supports the work of our Minstry Teams, Committees, and Lay School of Religion. 13 cents is used for administration which includes maintaining the building (where many of our Ministry Teams/Committees meet) and maintaining records of pastors, churches, programs etc..
