Community of Practice (COP) groups, help ministers to continually renew their own faith and ministry practices. While each group is unique, they all have a common structure and format. Members:

- Worship and pray
- Discuss common issues
- Share helpful resources
- Improve ministry skills
- Experience personal support and accountability

Each group is facilitated by a clergy colleague who receives specialized training and financial support in their role. Groups meet monthly, in person or by Zoom, usually from September through May. Being active in a COP group fulfills the Northwest Ohio Association Periodic Support Consultation requirement.

The participation fee is \$250 per program year (new clergy \$150). Churches and institutions are encouraged to pay this fee for their ministers. Scholarships are available from the Association office.
